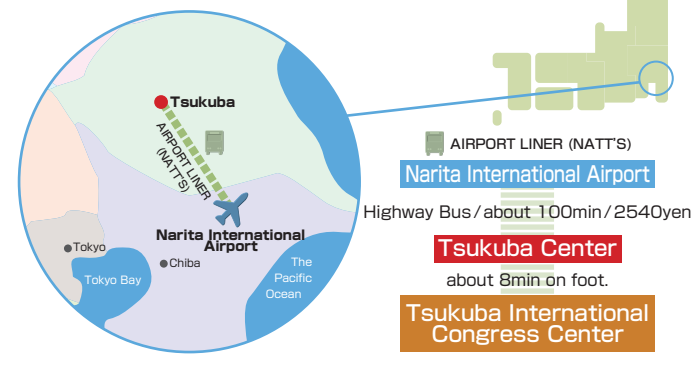
**• Instructions for abstracts submission**

Computer Input: MS Word 97 and above. If other compatible softwares employ, contact abstract-apvs@apvs2009.org before submission. Paper Size: A4 (21.0 cm x 29.7 cm or 8.27 inches x 11.69 inches), Margin: 3.0 cm vertical, 2.5 cm horizontal, Font: Times New Roman 10 pt. The abstract comprises title, author(s) (underline the speaker), affiliations and content of the abstract. The text should state clearly the objective, materials and methods, results, discussion and conclusions of the study. Only one page is accepted.

**• Instructions for poster presentation**

The poster should comprise following subheadings: title, author(s), affiliations, abstract, introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion, and/or references. Headings should have the smallest letters in 80-point font. The font in the text should not be smaller than 36-points. The size of a poster board is 90 cm wide and 120 cm high. The delegates can bring the ready posters to the congress.

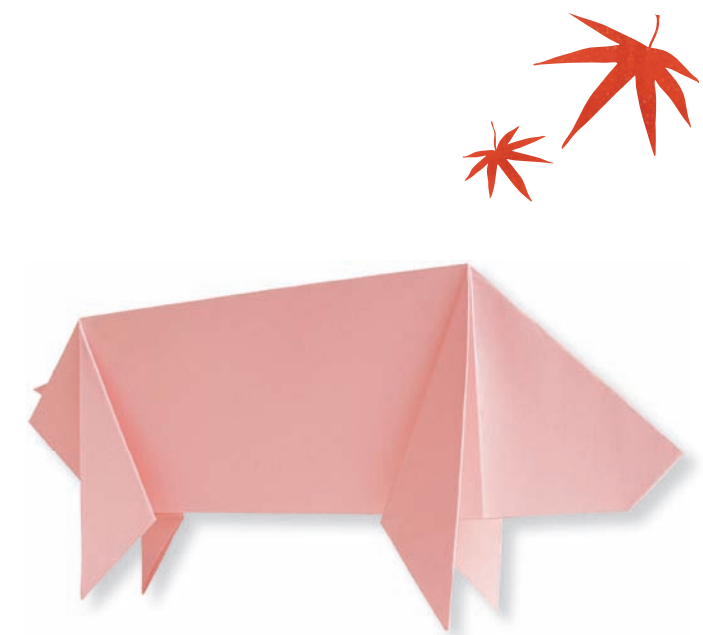

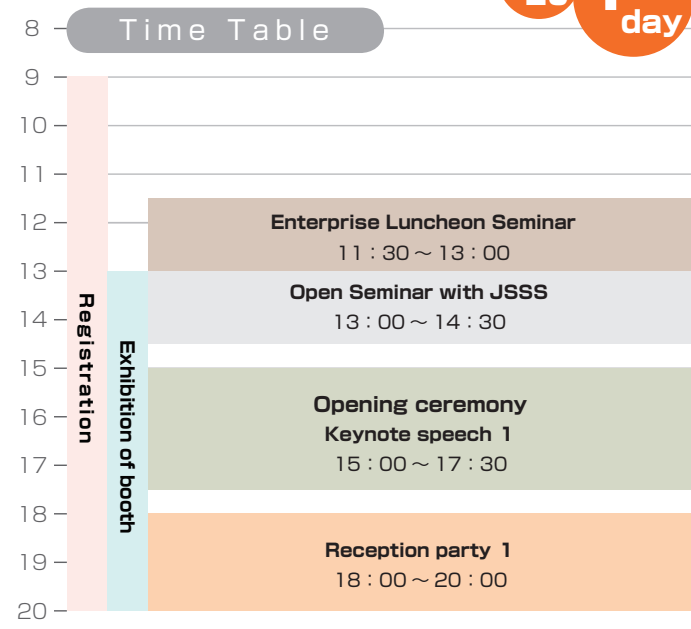

I wish to see you all in Tsukuba, October 2009.



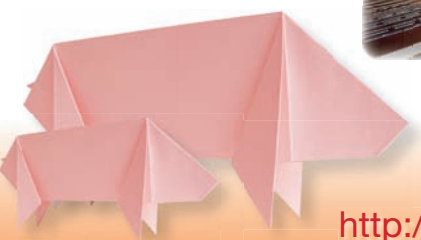

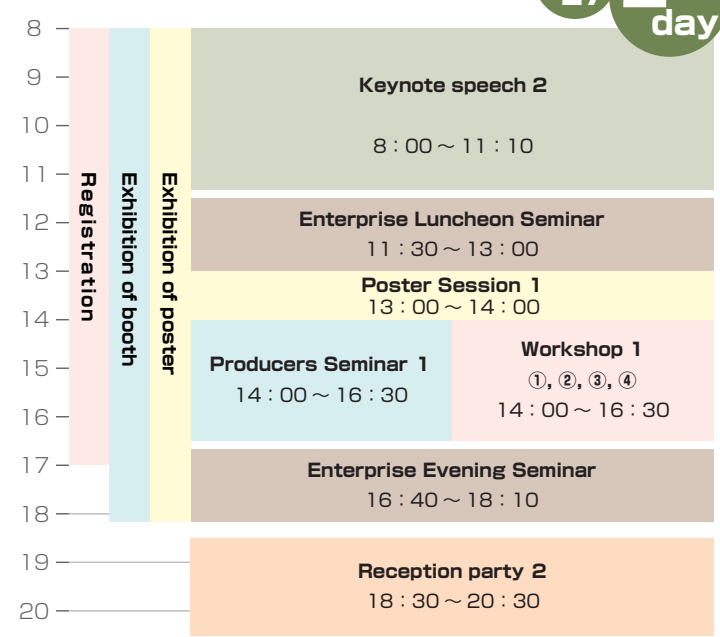

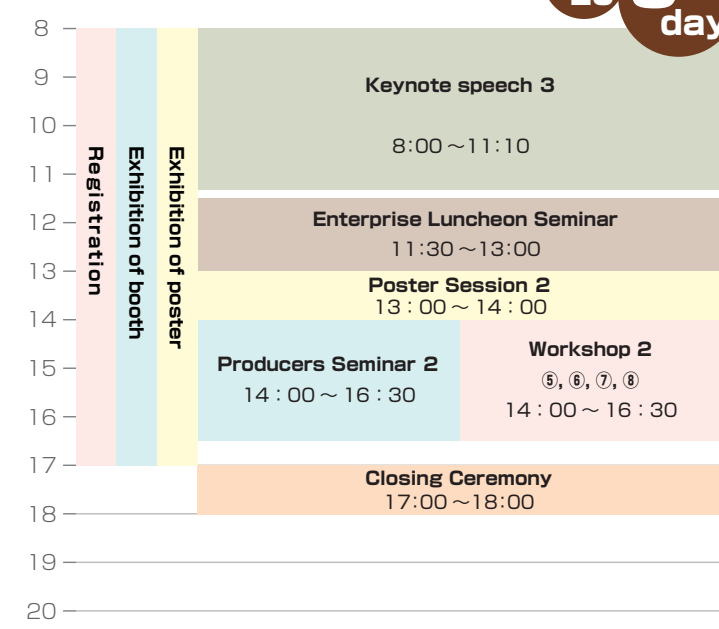
